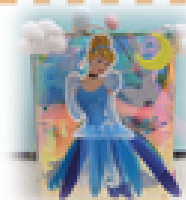

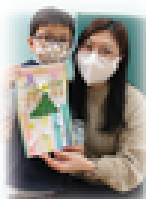

Teachers teach students in class patiently and also advise us parents on how to teach our children at home helpfully. My daughter has made remarkable progress in all aspects. First of all, in speaking ability, she knows more new words. Secondly, in social skills, she knows how to take the initiative to wave her hand to show friendliness. In addition, she is politer. She had learned to say good morning in the morning and goodbye when she leaves. What's more, in obeying rules, she learns the need about lining up. Ms. Lau also guides me that I could add a "Calm Down Area" at home. When my daughter is naughty, I can let her sit on a chair in "Calm Down Area" where she can't do anything in two minutes. By using this method continuously, she understands that naughtiness comes at a price.

Now, with the home-school partnership, she spends less time in naughtiness and more time seating and can focus on her school and work better. Tung Tung also likes to go to school every day. She wakes up consciously and says she wants to go to school actively, therefore she goes to school on time.

It is very surprising that the principal and teachers can identify my daughter in the morning even if she wears a mask. That's also my first impression of the school. In view of my daughter's age, she started school at the beginning of September. In the first three weeks, she cried to school every day. However, Principal Chan, teachers and other staff in the school welcome every child every morning at the school gate. They take children from parents and bring them to the kindergarten. They offer our kids enough sense of security so that they can quickly adapt to a new environment. Moreover, the class teacher, Ms. Lau, tells me my daughter's details in the school every day, so I can have a deep understanding of my daughter's life in the kindergarten. Principal Chan, teachers and other staff make efforts to create an environment suitable for young children to learn and grow. It makes me, a new mother, feel relieved to put my child in their trust.

Having witnessed my daughter's continuous growth and progress day after day in just two months, I'd like to express my sincere gratitude to staff at St. Peter's Church Kindergarten (Stanley), especially to Principal Chan, class teacher Ms. Lau, Ms. Yu, Ms. Rainbow and caregivers for your sincere dedication and attentive teaching. We thank the ongoing help of kindergarten from the bottom of our hearts which gives Gloria the courage to face her limitation and learn how to solve them.
